INTERSECTION is an integrated project co-founded by the European Commission in the frame of the 7th Framework Programme. The project aims at providing the protection of heterogeneous informatics networks and intersections points of different interconnected providers. The main elements considered are:

- Threats derived from cyberspace.
- Errors in the information exchange.
- Chain reactions for incorrect relations between infrastructures.
- Terrorist attacks.

For that reason, the project has:

- Identified and arranged vulnerable points of the infrastructures interconnected networks.
- Create a European database with the points of interconnected infrastructures.
- Identified possible countermeasures in case of threats.
- Developed a quick on-line monitoring.
- Designed and achieved an integrated security structure.

The networks cooperation it is an important defence against a variety of threats. There are four kind of cooperation:

1. Preliminary Cooperative – try to anticipate the threats.
2. Detection Cooperative – detect the threat when it breaks the protecting barriers.
3. Reaction Cooperative – react to the threat.
4. Toleration Cooperative – tolerated intrusions.
